Notes

Revenues (34.911,94 €):

- 4.428,06 € lower than budgeted, primarily due to Internoise income
- Membership payments for 2021 were 22.850 €:
 - All 2021 membership fees except for 1 Small and 1 Institutional member were paid. 2 Sponsor members withdrew their memberships in 2021.
 - Any outstanding fees and credit notes for previous years were added to the 2020 invoices. This
 remains a significantly lower figure than in previous years. See the Assets Statement concerning
 outstanding fees and credits.
- Assets written off: -780,75 € were written off in internet fee assets due to the redesign of the I-INCE.org webpage initiated and the handover of responsibility for the site to the new VP Communications.
- Liabilities change: 4.250,00 € (see also the Assets Statement)
 - waiving of the Lecture Videos fees (lecturing and editing) for 2018 (budget 2500 €) and 2019 (budget 1750 €)
 - Refund of overpayment in a previous year to OAL (75 €) completed
- Interest: none received as bank interest rates are zero or less
- Internoise 2020: due to the change in format of the conference and the reduced registration fees, the fee per full registration to I-INCE was reduced to 16,17 USD (13,93 €). Although 617 full registrations were higher than the budgeted 500, the income (8.592,69 €) was under budget.

Expenses (30.828,65 €)

- Significantly lower than budgeted (by 19.756,35 €), primarily due to significantly lower scientific costs and slightly lower administrative support costs. Most activities were either not required or involved reduced costs.
- Scientific support: 29.225,19 € compared to a budget of 43.195,00 €
 - NNI support 2020: 3.543,70 € (4114,56 USD) is lower than the budget of 6.500,00 (based on € 7,215 USD (6070 €) plus an exchange rate safety margin), primarily due to less travel, and thus, after the audit of NNI's 2020 accounts, I-INCE's support contribution was agreed and ratified. Note: The INCE/I-INCE Memorandum of Understanding states that 50% of net expenses are payable after approval of the NNI annual financial accounting. In accordance with practice agreed between I-INCE and INCE-USA, and ratified by the auditor and the Board, this post concerns the previous financial year due to the need to finalise and audit the NNI accounts.
 - ICA fees of 700 € is unchanged but above budget due to a budget error.
 - Conference database: 8.161,76 € (9476,54 USD) is lower than the 10.000,00 € budget, and after
 the audit of the Conference database 2020 accounts, I-INCE's support contribution (50% of net
 expenses) was agreed and ratified. Note: this post concerns the previous financial year due to the
 need to finalise and audit the accounts.
 - Support to young participants (grants and workshop):
 - Expenses are higher than the 13.500,00 € budget.
 - 14.288,10 € covers payment of 6735,04 € for grants for conference registration for 2020 and 2021 of 5740 USD, and additional support of 2080 USD for the Latin America Young Professionals Grant provided at Internoise 2021.
 - As grants were higher than the fees, a portion of each grant was deferred, resulting in 7.553,06 € added as liabilities (see the Assets Statement).
 - There was no workshop due to Internoise 2021 being virtual.
 - 10 years registration from 2019-2028 was paid in 2018. 45,00 € is the amortised amount for 2021
 - Internoise website template, hosting and maintenance: 2.486,63 € is slightly lower than budget (2.875,00 € +125,00 €).
 - Note: There is a proposal for change in Internoise funding from 2022 onwards
 - International Year of Sound 2020/21: No costs as no additional activities were required
 - Technical activity "Practice School" pilot project: No costs as no additional activities were required due to virtual Internoise. This recurring event is under trial and had a budget of 2.500,00 €. See VP Tech Activities Report
 - I-INCE symposium 2021: 5.000,00 € was reserved in the budget for approved proposals. There was no approved symposium

- Future Congress Planning lunch and AV support: No costs as no additional activities were required due to virtual Internoise. 2.000,00 € was reserved in the budget for continued trial.
- Scientific support is under budget by 13.969,81 € as several activities were not required, and as many of the remaining posts were less expensive than expected
- Functional support 1603,46 €:
 - Cost secretariat and treasurer operations: 355,34 € consisting of a Zoom license (277,14 €), postal costs 45,00 € and Treasurer costs of 33,2 €. This is significantly lower than the 4.000 € budgeted. See also the Assets Statement for debits owed.
 - Special cost Board Meeting + travel support: No costs were incurred as Internoise 2020 was virtual.
 - I-INCE website costs were lower than budgeted for
 - Transfer & bank costs: Lower than budgeted for. Money transfer costs outside Europe are minimized where possible.
 - Lawyer support: work to finalise the I-INCE taxation status required assistance and documentation of 114,32 €, slightly lower than budget.
 - Functional costs are significantly lower than budgeted.

Final results (4.083,29 €)

• The final result a small profit instead of a net loss that was budgeted for (-11.245,00 €). This is primarily due to lower costs.
