Internoise 2024

In order to minimize bank transfer costs, I-INCE income was combined with the I-INCE expenses that the Internoise conference managed and the net result of 24,175.00 € was transferred from the Internoise conference to I-INCE without bank costs. The posts are shown here for clarity. See also the notes on the individual posts.

Revenues (61.821,35 €):

- 15.191,35 € higher than budgeted, primarily due to Internoise income
- Membership for 2024 are 21.990 € but actual payment was 400,00 € lower (see below).
 - All but two 2024 membership fees were paid in full
 - IAA could not pay due to issues with their bank account. 300 EUR is credited in the balance report
 - I-INCE Executive granted TAS a reduced membership fee of 200 EUR for 2024 only, instead of 300 EUR due to an extraordinary recognition of the exchange rate situation where the Turkish Lire has lost 80% of its value compared to the Euro over the last 5 years, and with a reduction of over 30% in the last 12 months. The remaining 100 EUR was covered by I-INCE.
 - There were no changes in any membership categories.
 - 1 Sustaining member withdrew.
 - There was 1 less Institutional member than the budget as the new member expected did not materialise
 - o 1 membership for 2025 was paid for in advance in 2024.
 - See the Assets Statement concerning outstanding fees and credits.
- Interest: 981,35 €. Higher than usual.
- Internoise 2024: 38.850,00 €. The fee per full registration to I-INCE was 30 €. 1195 full registrations were higher than the budgeted 700. 3.000,00 € is for the Inter.noise website reimbursement.

Expenses (42.189,37 €)

- Significantly below budget by -15.585,64 €, caused by lower scientific and administrative support costs.
- Scientific support: 38.569,13 € is significantly below the budget of 48.950,00 €.
 - NNI support 2023: 6.288,45 € (6.288,45 USD) is below the budget of 9.000,00 € which includes 2.000,00 € for promotion, 223,18 USD (ca 190 €) of which was used. The remaining promotion budget (1810 €) is deferred to 2025
 - Note: The INCE/I-INCE Memorandum of Understanding states that 50% of net expenses are payable after approval of the NNI annual financial accounting. In accordance with practice agreed between I-INCE and INCE-USA, and ratified by the auditor and the Board, this post concerns the previous financial year due to the need to finalise and audit the NNI accounts.
 - ICA fees of 700 € is unchanged and on budget.
 - Conference database: 13.317,58 € (13846,26 USD) is higher than the 12.000,00 € budget due to the number of papers, and after the audit of the Conference database accounts, I-INCE's support contribution (50% of net expenses) was agreed and ratified.
 - Support to young participants (grants and workshop):
 - o 13.000,00 € was spent, below the budget of 16.000,00 €.

- Due to an oversight with the handover of the relevant VP role, the 20 Young Professional Grants awarded were for only 600 € instead of the 700 € budgeted
- The cost for the ceremony and the workshop were 1.000,00 €, lower than the 2.000,00 € budget for this post.
- Activities aimed at professionals: The budget of 3.000,00 € to support the new VP was not used and is moved to 2025.
- Internoise website template, hosting, development and maintenance:
 - The 3.838,10 €-spent exceeds the budget of 3.300,00 €.
 - Payment to the maintenance and development sub-contractor for 2024 (3.365,95 €) was done in 2023.
 - 645,20 EUR expenses covering costs for 2023 and 2024 were reported this year by that period's VP Communications & Webmaster. For simplicity, 2023 costs are included in 2024 expenses. 209,09 € was paid in 2023 for SSL for Internoise 2021, and 436,11 in 2024 for Internoise 2024-30 domain registration for 2 years, amortised to 2024 as 218,05 €, with 218,06 € amortised to 2025 and registered as credit.
 - The amortised amount for 2024 for the previous payment for 10 years registration of the Internoise.org domain from 2020-2028 was paid in 2019 is 45,00 €.
 - Notes:
 - The Internoise 2024 contract includes 3.000,00 € funding to help cover these costs
 - After the budget was approved, it was agreed that, should the VPs for Outreach and the Web require website development to improve the content, 1.000,00 € was available. This was not used.
 - After the budget was approved, it was discovered that SSL certificates are needed for Internoise conference archives (which covers 5 sites) as described in the relevant 2024 VP report. There is currently SSL for internoise 2021 but not for the other sites. The expected cost for SSL for 5 sites is \$1,200 for 5 years. It is needed (only) for the latest web format which is used for sites from 2021 and onwards and therefore covers the Internoise 2022-2026 sites. This expense is expected in 2025.
 - See also the Assets Statement.
- Technical activity "Practice School" pilot project: 1.425,00 € costs were incurred compared to the budget of 2.500.00 €.
- Future Congress Planning lunch and AV support: No costs were incurred as this was sponsored by Internoise 2024. 2.200,00 € had been reserved in the budget for continued trial.
- Note: No proposals for I-INCE symposium support or website development concerning outreach were approved either prior to or after the budget was approved.
- Functional support 3.703,87 €, lower than budgeted, despite unforeseen costs:
 - Cost secretariat and treasurer operations: 194,36 € consisting of a Zoom license (174,88 €) and Treasurer costs 2024 of 8,21 € (payment deferred). This is significantly lower than the 2.200 € budgeted as funding for additional assistance was not requested. See also the Assets Statement.
 - Special cost Board Meeting + travel support: 1.325,00 € was spent with 525,00 € on the board meeting and a contribution to the chairs dinner for accompanying persons, and 800,00 € travel support for 1 Board member. This post was below the budgeted 4.500,00 €.
 - I-INCE website template, hosting and maintenance: The 1.624,36 € spent is significantly above the budget of 1.225,00 €.
 - Development and maintenance was 1.091,70 €. The payment to the sub-contractor was done in 2023.
 - 645,20 € expenses covering costs for 2024 were reported this year by that period's VP Communications & Webmaster.
 - 418,15 € was paid for technical assistance from GoDaddy.
 - After the budget was approved it was identified that <u>i-ince.org</u> needed to be renewed in 2024. The estimated cost was €431 for 3 years for the period up to 2027 including SSL. 353,94 € was paid for domain registration in 2024 for 2 years, amortised to 2024 as 176,97 €, with the same amount amortised to 2025.
 - 21,17 € relates to the amortization of the registration of the i-ince.org domain for 5 years.
 - See also the Assets Statement.

- Transfer & bank costs: 264,29 €. Lower than the 900 € budget and less than 2023. Money transfer costs outside Euro zone are minimized where possible.
- Professional support: Although no costs were budgeted, 223,50 € was used on authorised translators fees for the Beneficial Owner documentation required by the bank.

Final results (19.548,36 €)

• The final result is a large profit instead of the budgeted loss (10.145,00 €). This is primarily due to higher Internoise income and lower scientific costs, although administration costs were also less.
